



Glenview Park District Outdoor Pool Closure Policy -2009

A decision to close Glenview Park District's outdoor pools, Flick Pool and Roosevelt Pool, may be made by the Aquatics Supervisor, Assistant Aquatics Supervisor or the Manager of Programs for any of the following reasons:

- If the air temperature reaches 66 degrees or below, or there are fewer than 25 swimmers in the facility anytime after 4 pm.
- If lightning and/or thunder is in the area and/or the Thorguard Protection system issues a warning, the pool will be cleared and will not reopen until an all clear siren (3 short blasts) is heard. If conditions force two consecutive 30-minute closures, the pool may be closed until 4 pm. The weather will be re-evaluated at 4 pm to determine whether the facility will reopen for the evening session from 5 pm to closing. If the consecutive closings occur during the evening session, the pool will close for the remainder of the day.
- The pools will be closed when a situation arises that would jeopardize the public health or safety of patrons in attendance.

Whenever a decision is made to close the pool in any of these situations, pool staff will notify the Administration Office, Splash Landings, and Park Center of the closing and update the recorded message at 847-724-3337, option 4, for public information.
